5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Lent -April 3, 2022

"Do not remember the former things, or consider the things of old. I am about to do a new thing; now it springs forth, do you not perceive it? I will make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert." —

Isaiah 43:18-19

If you sometimes feel overwhelmed by the direction the climate crisis is going, consider reading chapter 43 from Isaiah as an antidote. Or read chapter 3 of Pope Francis' *Laudato Si'* (you can find it online for free). He reminds us, "The Spirit of God has filled the universe with possibilities and therefore, from the very heart of things, something new can always emerge" (#80).
