Let's take a look at the logo which reminds us that the pilgrim's journey is not an individual undertaking but rather a communal journey.



Four Figures: represent humanity from the four corners of the earth, embracing the solidarity and fraternity that unites people

Cross: Sign of our faith which is dynamic and bends towards humanity to offer them the certainty of its presence

Anchor: universal symbol of hope which dips down into the waves giving us security and hope

Waves: which remind us that the pilgrimage of life does not always move in calm waters

The Jubilee calls us to set forth on a journey. For each of us, the journey will be different. The beginning of any journey is when we make the decision to start out and then we set out a plan. The journey will take place gradually as there are various routes to choose from and places to discover. And as always, there are detours that may set us on a new road to a miraculous discovery.
