Canonization Corner	
St. Jose Gregorio Hernandez	
	
AKA: “Doctor of the Needs” or “Doctor of the Poor”	
<b>Born:</b> Oct 26, 1864 Isnotu, Venezuela	
<b>Died:</b> June 29, 1919 Caracas Venezuela	
<b>Beatified:</b> April 30, 2021 by Pope Francis	
<b>Canonized:</b> Oct. 19, 2025 by Pope Leo	
<b>Patron Saint:</b> Medical students, Diagnosticians Doctors, Medical patients	
Dr. José Gregorio Hernández, a Venezuelan physician and member of the Secular Franciscan Order, is widely known, respected and venerated in many countries. A witness of holiness, he was a man full of virtue and performed exemplary medical services to patients from all walks of life. Throughout his career as a distinguished university professor, he made many contributions to the field of medical science and quenched his thirst for the charism of <b>Saint Francis of Assisi</b> through his commitment to the Franciscan Order. Between 1891 and 1916, Hernández taught medicine and practiced as a doctor. He tried twice to become a priest, however his health was too fragile. In true Apostolic zeal, although not able to fulfill his own aspirations of becoming a priest, he remained available to God’s designs and plans for him. He was known for helping poor people and dedicating hours serving those most in need, treating them for free. He died at the age of 55 in a car accident, while he was going to buy medicine for a poor sick patient. In his beatification, Pope Francis recalled “... he was above all a doctor close to the weakest, so much so that he was known in his homeland as <b>'the doctor of the poor'</b> . Not interested in	

monetary wealth, he was drawn instead to the richness of the Gospel. In the poor, the sick, the migrants, the suffering, José Gregorio saw Jesus." His selfless giving to the world earned him many names: 'saint of the people,' 'apostle of charity,' and 'missionary of hope.'
