Year of St. Francis
10 Facts You May Not Know!

- 1. **He was a Prisoner of War:** As a young man, he fought against Perugia, was captured, and spent about a year in prison before his dramatic conversion.
- 2. **His Name Meant "Frenchman":** Born Giovanni, his wealthy father renamed him "Francesco" (Francis) due to his love for French culture and trade.
- 3. **He created the First Live Nativity:** In 1223, he staged the first nativity scene with real people and animals in Greccio, Italy, to help people feel closer to Jesus' birth.
- 4. **He Spoke to Animals (and Birds):** He's famous for preaching to birds, wolves,

and other creatures, seeing them as brothers and sisters in God's creation.

- 5. **He Received the Stigmata:** In 1224, while praying, he received the wounds of Christ (stigmata) on his hands, feet, and side, a rare phenomenon.
- 6. **He Wrote Early Italian Literature:** His "Canticle of the Sun," praising creation, is one of the first major works in the Italian language, not Latin.
- 7. **He Renounced His Wealth Publicly:** After hearing God's call to "repair my church," Francis stripped naked in the town square, giving up his inheritance for a life of poverty.
- 8. **He Met the Sultan of Egypt:** During the Crusades, he traveled to Egypt to meet the Sultan, promoting peace rather than war.
- 9. **He Founded a Major Religious Order:** His simple life and message of poverty, peace, and love led to the establishment of the Franciscan Order.
- 10. **He's the Patron Saint of Many Things:** He's the patron saint of animals, the environment, peace, merchants, and Italy, among others, reflecting his broad impact.

DID YOU KNOW: The tomb of St Francis of Assisi was hidden and rediscovered centuries later. To protect his remains from invasion, the Franciscans concealed his tomb. Its location was forgotten until it was rediscovered in 1818.
